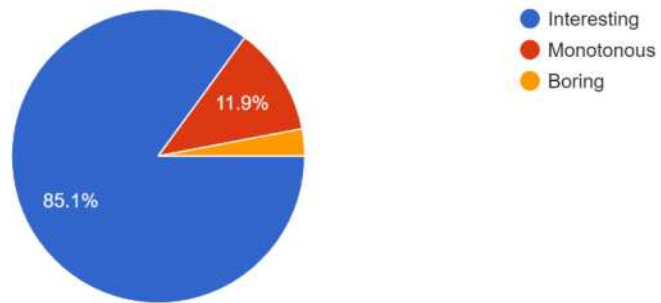

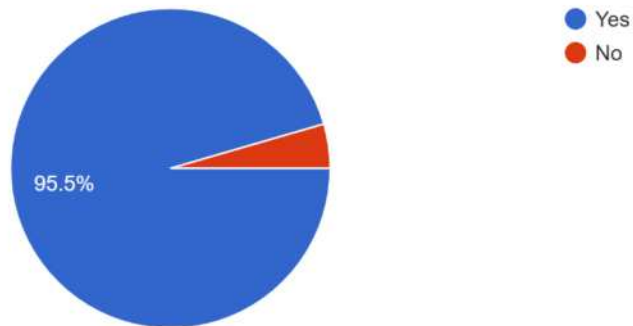

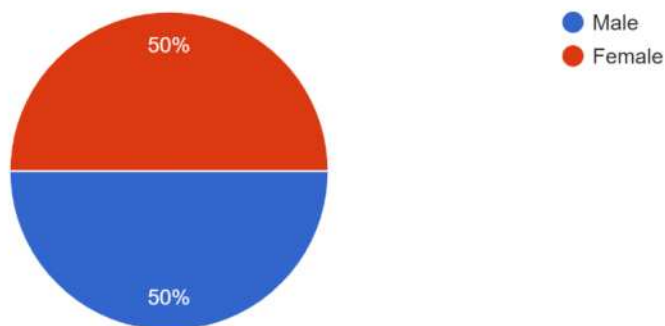


3. Alumni Feedback

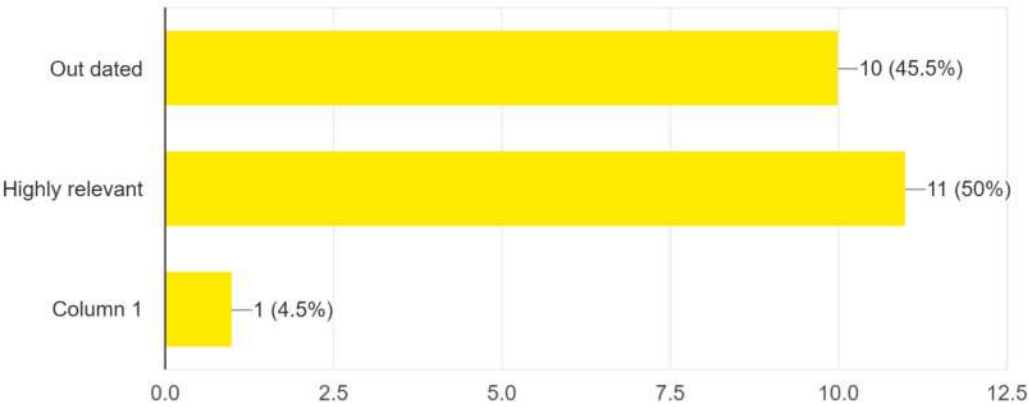
Rank the Architectural Design Studios conducted for their ability to progressively better your problem solving skills and design abilities ?

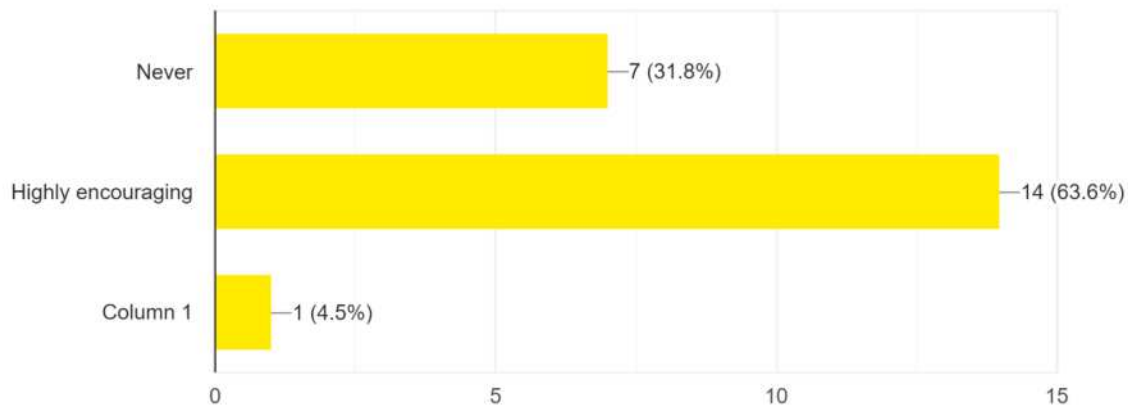

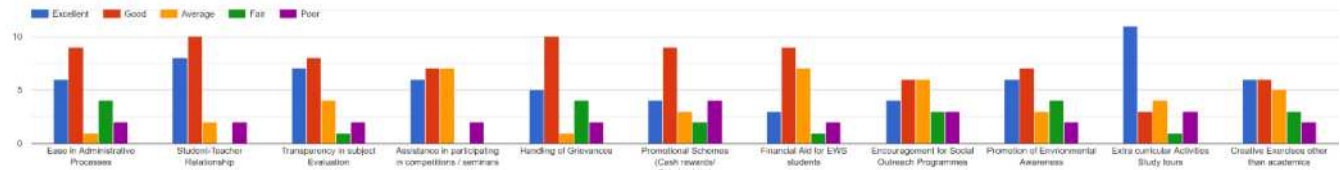

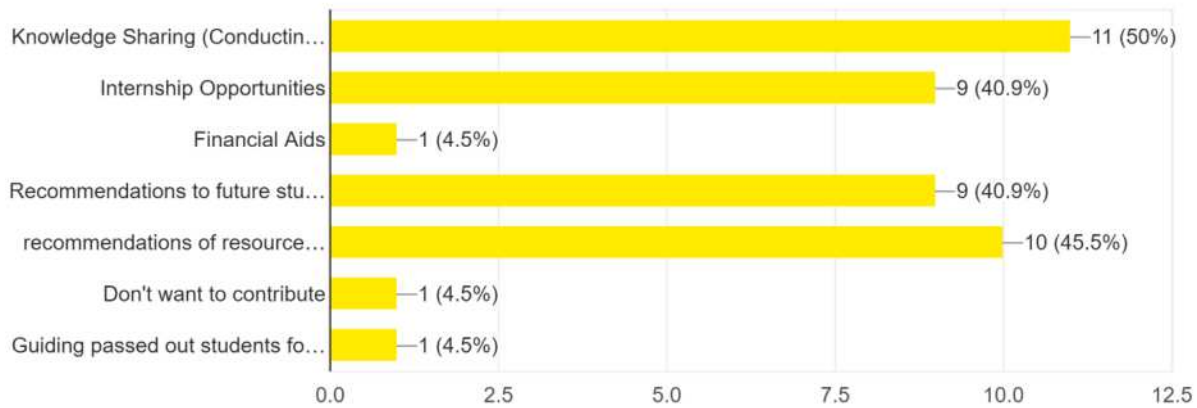

4. Analysis on suggestions received and action taken
